Reeferman's Seed Catalog Summer 2006:

Inbred Lines (\$120 for 12, no 6 packs)

Our IBL's are derived from true landrace genetics, collected in the region of origin.

These special strains have only been inbred, never hybridized, and are ideal for breeding purposes. These plants grow very well on their own but their true value lies in the creation of new F1 hybrids. All the inbreds are adapted to Northern climates and will exhibit hybrid vigor when crossed to an unrelated strain. We are releasing these to hobby breeders in the hopes that people will make, save and trade their own seed instead of giving us their hard-earned money!

Seriously though, y'all need to think about what you're going to do if it becomes necessary for us to stop shipping to America.

Burmese: A rare sativa, Burmese gives beautiful plants that look like indica hybrids, but smoke like a true sativa, with exotic sweet aromas and an uplifting, anti-anxiety high. We are big fans of Burmese hybrids, as you'll see on the next few pages!

Highland Afghani: This true Affie line is sure to satisfy hardcore, old school indica lovers with its hashy flavors and high THC levels. Short, sturdy plants that can resist the rigors of autumn in the harsh mountains of Afghanistan will do well anywhere.

Lebanese Hashplant: The breeding parent of Reeferman's Hashplant, Leb is very suitable for outdoor seed production. Good for indica breeders. Adapted to Northern climates through generations of inbreeding.

Nigerian: The father of Nightmare, Nigerian

has earthy aromas of carrot and mango and a slightly racy, exciting sativa high. A good choice to freshen up tired indica strains. 10-12 weeks indoor, mid-late September outdoors.

Turkish: Our inbred version of an ancient Turkish landrace, used for hashish production for hundreds of years.

Hybrid Lines (\$100 for 12 or \$60 for 6 except as marked)

All of our hybrids have been selected from large populations and extensively tested for quality and ease of growth. The majority of our sales are to repeat customers who count on us to fill their gardens with pungent, heavy harvests of potent plants that perform as advertised. Asia Girl: [Thai x Nepalese] x [(Thai x Nepalese) x RM's NL]. Watch out, Asia Girl has come to town! Super sativa structure but well behaved with lateral branches.

Thai-dominant high with the added crystal of NL#5. She will rock your world! Amongst the breeders' favorites.

Bubba Kush S1's (\$150 for 12, \$85 for 6)

These all-female seeds produced by selfing the famous Bubba Kush clone grow very uniformly, like clones, and carry the same great taste and Kush high of the original.

Burmese Delight: This one is a gourmet treat, a real crowd pleaser, incredibly rich intoxicating aroma, with a smooth strong high that can be felt from the heart up to the top of the skull, a real head massager with a feel-good high. Just covered in frost, the Burmese Delight will yield decently indoors on tables or as larger plants, and quickly for a sativa dominant strain. Around 10% will be exceptional yielders. Fantastic outdoor headies, but a drier climate is recommended.

Cherry Bomb II: We have obtained Cherry Bomb from several sources, the original

being from California and our most recent acquisition coming from Mr. Greengenes.

His 100% sativa Cherry Bomb meets the indica-dominant California cutting to create the ultimate in cherry explosion, like an orgasm in a rolling paper! A soaring high, real sativa dominant buzz, with full-on cherry candy flavor and smell make this Cherry Bomb the best ever. High yielding, easy trimming, old school red hair, nice fat sativa dominant nuggies.

Cinderella 99: Our F4 version of the famous 50 day sativa created by the Brothers Grimm. Sweet smells of grapefruit and pineapple with a racy sativa buzz.

Crystal Ship: A cross of a super-resinous Kali Mist indica pheno with our F8 Kodiak Gold father results in a rich citrus aroma with mega crystal production. Superb bag appeal. Smooth satisfying high with a nice sativa-indica effect. Excellent on tables.

Full Melt Madness: A smooth sativa smoke that tastes like grapefruit with orange undertones. We received this true-breeding strain with very little background, only that it was originally an African sativa cross that was stabilized over many generations. Nevertheless, we have grown to love this one! It makes wonderful hash and oil, with a pleasantly zippy and creative buzz. Great daytime smoke.

G13 x Blueberry Sativa: Blue Sat provides the fruity flavor and G13 the weight in this astonishing F1 hybrid. The G13 cutting, popularized by Airborne, has proven its worth in many crosses, where her sativa-dominant high, short flowering time, high yields, and dense bud structure complements many sativas and makes them manageable under lights. This F1 preserves the long lasting, blissful, thought-provoking experience of the rare Blueberry Sativa, with denser buds than the original.

G13 x Burmese: This hybrid maintains the wonderful sativa high and exotic flavors of our Burmese IBL, with G13 again lending bud density and raw THC to the mix.

Grapefruit: Reeferman's take on the old BC standby, the original Sweet Pink Grapefruit made famous by Spice of Life. Improved potency with the same great bag appeal and quick finish. Lots of crystals and strong grapefruit aroma.

Herijuana: Using select Herijuana seeds from the original breeder, we have taken the sativa pheno and crossed it back to the indica pheno. Really nice smoke in every senses of the word, with a nice balanced high and super crystal production. A wonderful outdoor plant for coastal climates, a proven performer from Humboldt County to British Columbia.

King's Kross: (Winner, Best Hash, IC Magazine 4/20 cup, 2005) This pure indica hybrid, well on its way to becoming a legend, traces back to OG Kush and Charles' Kush.

Kodiak Gold: The original from Kodiak Island, Alaska, this is some strong and long-lasting herb that is proven medicine for many conditions, such as hepatitis C and HIV. 40% sativa but still very early outside, KG makes some sparkly golden to lavender colored rock-hard buds that are just rich in fragrance. Our most mold-resistant strain.

Lowryder: These novelties will flower under continuous light, making them perfect for midsummer grows on the balcony.

Love Potion #1: (\$75 for 12, \$45 for 6. Winner, Best Sativa, High Times Cannabis Cup, 2004) Rarely in our times comes a sativa of megalithic proportions.

Devastating lemony harvests of purely potent sativa leave the tired old cuttings of yesteryear obsolete and abandoned in the hobbles of Olde Europe. Love Potion #1 merges the old world with the new to bring you the new standard in quality genetics.

G13 x Santa Marta Columbian Gold, backcrossed to SMCG.

Major Wreck: The Trainwreck has become a very popular cutting in NorCal in recent years. This unique version is very consistent

from plant to plant, they grow like clones with a lemony scent and taste and a flying high that still slightly stonies. One of our best new lines in recent years.

Manga Haze: An extremely easy Haze to grow, even for first-timers. Neville's Haze is crossed with the Manga Rosa sativa from Brazil, with a little Afghani thrown in to keep them manageable indoors.

Nigerian Nightmare: A phenomenal early sativa hybrid with an aroma of carrot and mango. Can yield quite well in hot southern climates.

Northern Lights: A genuine NL seedline, derived from Neville's stock, which came straight from the original (Afghani x Thai) x Afghani hybrid created in Seattle in the mid '80's. High yields, easy to grow, clones well.

Odin's Hammer: Odin kept his hammer in his pants, only the ladies and an occasional enemy he wished to defile ever saw it, so the legend goes... This is an F₁ hybrid comprised of Kodiak Gold and Acapulco Gold. The Hammer offers some real WHACK in the head department, as both parents are some real head hitters. Great weed for sex and frolick!

Petrolia Headstash (\$200 for 12, \$110 for 6): A highly coveted true-breeding strain from Humboldt County, a pre-Soviet import from Afghanistan inbred by oldtimers for over two decades. Pungent, rock-hard nugs that hit hard, producing a strong body buzz that lasts for hours. High THC, hardy outdoor strain, makes great old-school Afghani hash. Mother of Herijuana.

Phnom Penh: Coming to you from the Cambodian capital by way of Vancouver Island, this PP is anything but average! Crossing to a Thai x Haze father tames the wild sativa just a little bit, without losing the psychedelic stone and spicy incense, black tea flavors of the Cambodian jungle weed. Not for beginners.

Reeferman's Hashplant: This state-of-the-art

hashplant is an exceptional hybrid well suited for commercial production in Sea of Green and DWC (water bucket) systems. A hardy strain, great for beginners as it is resistant to pests and disease. Excellent trichome production. AAA bag appeal, lime green, low odor, heavy indica buds on stalky plants.

Panama Red Skunk: *NEW* This one is going to be around for a while, amigos! PRS relies on the same parents and follows the same breeding scheme that produced the groundbreaking, world-changing Skunk #1, but we switched it up a bit to favor the Panama Red parent instead of the Columbian Gold. Spicy, sweet flavors and an amazing old-school high make this a unique blast from the past.

John Sinclair: We've renamed our Red Congolese sativa hybrid in honor of John Sinclair, the radical writer and thinker from the '60's who is taking his message from the streets to the internet with his new website, www.RadioFreeAmsterdam.com. John was the manager of the seminal Detroit rock band the MC5 and the founder of the White Panthers and folks, he keeps it real. In fact, I didn't know what 'real' was until I saw John keeping it. Check him out.

Much like the man himself, John Sinclair the strain promotes creative and unorthodox patterns of thought, and gets you up and moving! Super frosty plants produce aromas like sandalwood and honey with a hint of haze. The anti-couchlock, great for artists.

Senor Garcia: Oregon Purple Thai x Panama Red. A trippy sativa in honor of Jerry. A joint of this will send you on a journey through space and time. For experienced growers only, these plants are very touchy feeders preferring organics and a light feeding regimen, 1/3 to 1/2 strength. Striking purple hues and red hairs make this some pretty pot as well. A small % will be mutants due to the OPT influence. Very pleasant sweet and sour aromas.

Skunkaberry: A most delicious cross of

Newberry with a Chinese Indica male. One of our tastiest strains with sweet and skunky berry flavors and a relaxing indica dominant high. Good night time smoke. Easy to grow, decent mold resistance, also works well outdoors. Great SOG plant with excellent bag appeal. Supplies are limited, so order soon if you gotta have it!

Sugarwarp: A great outdoor strain that yields huge. Our sweet and frosty Burmese male was used to pollinate the 26 year old Timewarp cutting, resulting in a big yielding, sativa dominant plant that smells of sweet nectar and tropical fruits. Tasty, sweet fruity nuggets. The high is euphoric and long-lasting, without any paranoia. Huge yields outdoors, if you can let it go til mid-October.

Thunderfuck Haze: The classic Matanuska Thunderfuck indica mixes it up with a pure Haze sativa, giving an F₁ with excellent hybrid vigor and good mold resistance.

Tropical Timewarp: Big crazy sativas that kick ass in the Southern states, Australia and Southern Europe. Strong sativa buzz with a hint of indica that hits in the chest and follows with a case of the giggles. Sweet fruity tropical aromas. Super frosty lime green buds with red hairs.

Viper: Watch out, this one can sneak up on ya! Once again our proven Burmese male does the trick, smoothing out the BC Blackseed, which yields phenomenally but can smoke a bit rough on its own. It's not quite as yieldy as Blackseed, but has a more complex aroma, sweet skunky and piney with a pleasantly greasy texture on the tongue.

Willie Nelson (\$120): An F₁ hybrid between Vietnamese Black and Highland Nepalese. It's Willie's favorite smoke, he tried it once and bought the whole crop. What else do you need to know? How about a sweet and sour, lemongrassy flavor and a reasonable 10-12 week flowering time? Good mold resistance and a friendly, soaring high round out the package. Willie took home the 2005

High Times Cannabis Cup for Best Sativa.

Williejuana: Mr. Nelson meets the mythical, medicinal Herijuana cutting, and the results are astonishing. Heri takes the edge off the electric high of the pure Willie and puts on some weight as well.

William's Mango: The original William's Wonder makes an F₁ with BC Mango, and the results are superb. This was the big yielder in last year's field trials, the heavyweight champion of the RM 2006 collection. Works great indoors too! Piney and tropical fruit smells mingle in sturdy, sativa-indica hybrids with a classic Christmas tree shape and perfect symmetry.
